Develops and evaluates goals for planning and directing licensing functions to accomplish the broad objectives of the agency. This position is based out of the Concord, NH.

Minimum qualifications for this position is a Master's with major study in business administration, accounting human resources, public administration or related field. Six years' experience in public administration, business administration, accounting or related field, plus four years of supervisory experience in any occupational area. If related to the program area, the supervisory experience will count as part of the four years' total experience. Education and experience may be interchanged as appropriate.

Preferred Qualifications: Possession of software development, software support or software maintenance experience and/or experience with Charitable Gaming.

PREFERRED WORK TRAITS: Thorough knowledge of New Hampshire laws pertaining to specific program(s) supervised. Knowledge of report writing. Must be willing to maintain appearance appropriate to assigned duties and responsibilities as determined by the agency appointing authority.
