4. There will be three (3) drawings total held at the Commission headquarters. Each drawing will be announced at least thirty (30) days in advance of the Entry Deadline. Drawings will be determined based on ticket sales.
5. Tickets received after the Entry Deadline will be entered into the next available drawing; tickets received after the last drawing date will be set aside for destruction.
